

Regular SYAA Meeting

Meeting called to order @ 6:04 pm.

- Minutes from last meeting – Motioned by James, seconded by Dan to approve minutes. All approved
- New batting cages – Estimated cost: \$8,800 plus electrical (waiting on quote from Krause Electric)
 - Nelson’s steel estimate = \$2,500/cage
 - Albrecht’s dirt work = \$900
 - Nets \$1,800
 - Batting mats with home plates = \$630
 - L-screen for baseball = \$239 Softball = \$239
- Registration – Registration opened on February 1st, late fee will go into effect April 1st, hard cut off date is April 10th. We will send out half sheet notifications soon letting people know about our only in-person registration (March 24, coinciding with the baseball/softball clinic). Lori will talk to the superintendent Mr. Flynn about securing some Chrome books to use at the registration. Will also talk to the school about including information about registration in newsletter and/or mass texts.

- T-ball birthdates – the system is set up with only one birthdate (January 1st which is the cut off for softball, baseball is May 1st) so we will need to override the system for boys with birthdays before May 1st.
- Spirit Wear – Melissa Minard and Andrea Bowerman have requested to have spirit wear made up to sell. SYAA would make \$5 profit on each item sold. It was discussed and unanimously approved to support this endeavor.
- New Varsity coach, Ed Stermer, introduced himself to the group and talked a bit about his background and his hopes for the HS program.
